Heartfelt Ministry for the Women of Slicer St.

Heartfelt is a mentoring ministry designed to develop closer relationships across generations among the women in the church and to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ. It is for women of all ages and stages-from 18 to 103. This ministry is based on the principles of Titus 2:3-5.

3 Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but teach what is good. 4 Then they can urge the younger women to love their husbands and children, 5 to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.

Phase 1 will be getting women who will serve as Heart Moms. This is older women of the church who do not have children at home. You will become mentors and friends. There was a meeting last Sunday evening for those women and there was great participation

Phase 2 will be involving women to be Heart Sisters. This is younger women who may or may not have children but who want to learn and be served by Heart Moms. A meeting for Heart Sisters will be held this Sunday evening following services in the communion room.
