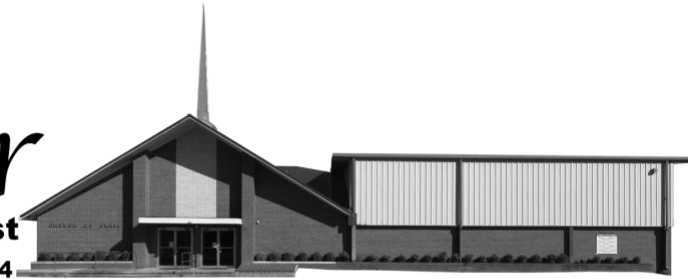

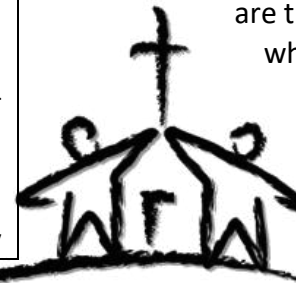

### "Be Careful Little Eyes what you See"

First Peter tells us that God is holy, therefore we must be holy. Holiness is a simple word that means to be set apart from the world without sin. Unfortunately, it seems to me that many of us try to see how far we can get in the other direction and still be counted as holy. This is especially true when it comes to our entertainment. How many of us have had to hurry our children out of the room before a television show we're watching uses language we don't want them to hear? If entertainment uses words or suggestive themes that are inappropriate for our children, who we're trying to raise to be godly, is it appropriate for us? Sometimes we'll tell our children that this is a show for big people and that they don't need to see it. When we do that, aren't we telling them that these are the shows they should be watching when they grow up? How about we take holiness seriously, for our children and for ourselves!
