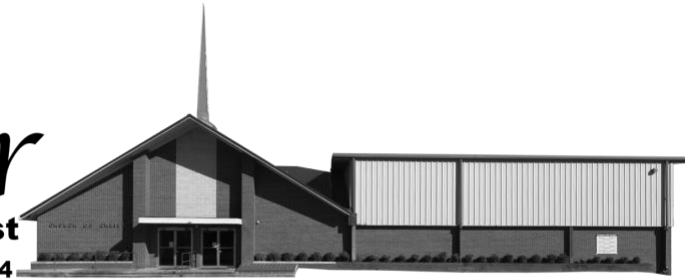

Looking through the gospels, you see that there were several reasons why people chose not to follow Jesus. Some did not believe his claim of authority. Others were not prepared to make him lord of their lives. Others were afraid of what they would have to give up. Others still could not accept his call to live counter culturally. The one reason not to follow Jesus that you will not find in the gospels, however, is that it would be boring. Scripture teaches that the life of a faithful Christian will be marked by several qualities: full of joy, spent in humble service, met with opposition, but never boring. How would you describe your walk with God? Is it ever mindless repetition, doing the same thing over and over again? Is it ever just going through the motions? Is it ever boring? If so, you're doing something wrong. Christianity can be overflowing with reasons to rejoice. It can even be a trying path to walk at times, but the one thing it should never be is boring.
